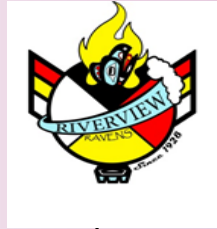

## April 2023 Newsletter

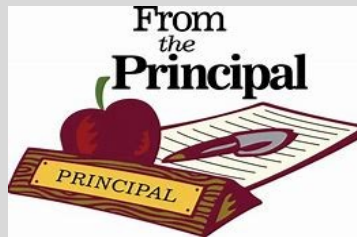

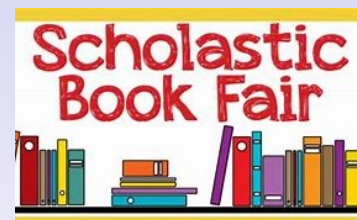


## **Book Fair**

## **Spring Weather & Dress Code Policy**

Just a reminder that with the warmer weather comes the shorts and tank tops. We remind students that clothing worn to school should follow the School District School Dress Code, Policy #306, which states, "A safe, positive and inclusive learning environment is supported by a dress code that encourages student expression of identity while maintaining procedures to ensure all schools and school-sponsored events are safe and inclusive.

If students do not meet dress code standards, they will be asked to find an alternate piece of clothing to wear or arrange for an immediate change of clothing.

## Student Learning Survey 2022/2023

The Provincial Student Learning Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools. It gathers information from parents/guardians/caregivers, teachers, and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective.

In April 2023 the Student Learning Survey will be administered to students in grades 4 and 7, their parents/guardians/caregivers, and all school staff. We encourage parents/guardians/caregivers to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement.

The surveys contain standard questions for the Province – in addition, questions from the school and/or district that focus on local conditions or issues may be included. The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on the Internet at [http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat\\_survey](http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey). Any computer with an Internet connection can be used, and access to the e-survey is simple and secure. The survey can be accessed through the link with or without an anonymous logon code by selecting the school district and school name where your child attends school. Provincial, District and School Reports for previous years can be viewed at the same site under the Results section.

The e-survey site will be open until April 29th.


