### **Bus New**

When morning temperatures are at -32 or colder or roads are deemed unsafe due to weather, radio announcements will be authorized by the Transportation Supervisor regarding the cancellation of bus transportation. Also, you can check the bus schedule on the School District 28 website.

**When school buses are not running in the morning, they are cancelled for the entire day.** Any students at school on a non-bus day will need to have alternate arrangements to be picked up on these days.

### **Daily Health Awareness**

It is important to remember health awareness. Health awareness reduces the likelihood of a person/child with illness coming to school when they are infectious. **This includes a person checking regularly that they or their child are not experiencing symptoms of illness (including but not limited to COVID-19 symptoms) to ensure they are not coming to school when they are sick.** This will help prevent the spread of germs and will keep our school community healthy.
